From Workers to Farmers... Thanks!, CIO-PAC poster (1944)



In 1944 Shahn joined the Political Action Committee of the Congress of Industrial Organizations (CIO-PAC) to help produce posters and other graphic materials for Roosevelt during that year's successful presidential campaign. The poster *From Workers to Farmers...Thanks!* was placed in rural settings to directly address farmers highlighting urban industrial workers appreciation of the farmers' contribution to the war effort. The farming imagery used in *Bountiful Harvest* came from Shahn's two trips through the Midwest. His initial trip as part of the Resettlement Administration (1935) focused on the poorest farmers. A second trip, in 1938, for the Farm Security Administration emphasized the productive lives of rural people and the benefits of the first steps toward economic recovery. *Bountiful Harvest*, 1944 is a powerful comment on the importance of the farmer's role in our nation's bounty.
